THE CONCEPT PLAN FOR THE **FIRST** CORNELIUS RECREATION + COMMUNITY CENTER



This project will renovate an existing building in alignment with the Town Center principles developed by the community, including:

- Creating a community gathering space and civic plaza;
- Celebrating and showcasing diversity; and
- Providing a safe space for vulnerable community members to shelter during emergencies.

This building is ideally situated in the heart of Cornelius, with key community resources either across the street or on the same block. Its close proximity to the fire and police departments makes it an ideal location to serve as an emergency shelter, while being next to the public library and elementary school allows for extended access to community resources. We are seeking funding to renovate this space into our first community and recreation center, creating a safe, welcoming hub for residents of all ages.
