Chair Kropf, Vice-Chair Chotzen, Vice-Chair Wallan, and Members of the Committee,  
I'm submitting testimony in opposition to HB 4106 on behalf of myself.  
At a time when the public is clamoring for law enforcement accountability, HB 4106  
moves in  
the opposite direction.  
HB 4106 would expand immunity by providing that, in addition to existing liability  
limits, a  
peace officer "may not be held criminally or civilly liable" for using restraints or  
physical force  
during the transportation of a person under Oregon's civil commitment and related  
statutes, so  
long as the officer reasonably believes the force/restraints are necessary to protect  
the person,  
the officer, or the public, and the officer acts in "good faith and without malice."
