Dear Members of the Oregon Legislature,

I strongly support and urge the passage of SJR 203. Nationwide, federal agents are terrorizing our communities with chemical munitions and brute force—while wearing masks to disguise their identities and hide from accountability. I believe that law enforcement should be held to the highest standard of integrity, which includes being identifiable to the communities in which they are sworn to protect and serve.

Other notable public-serving professionals, such as licensed medical professionals, mental health professionals, and educators have accountability measures to protect the public, such as the wearing of name tags while on the job as well as a licensure number that is searchable in public records. Such measures are in place within other public-serving professions to prevent malpractice and abuse of power. It is reasonable for law enforcement to be held to these same standards.

SJR 203 is necessary to protect our civil liberties and stand up for what is just. Anonymity puts our communities in danger of violence, instills fear, and ruptures trust in our democracy. Our neighborhoods demand no more “secret police” on our streets!
