The Bill promotes sustainable forest management by requiring the State Forester to regularly assess available state forestland and establish harvest levels that balance timber production with environmental health.

- It ensures accountability by allowing certain individuals and entities to seek court intervention if the State Forester fails to meet management or harvest requirements.
- The Bill mandates consideration of both state and federal legal requirements, including habitat conservation plans and the Oregon Forest Practices Act, helping protect wildlife and maintain compliance with environmental standards.
