The Multnomah County Commission strongly urges you to support the Community Economic Coalition's (CEC) \$1,000,000 request to support the purchase of a near-vacant building on East Burnside Street in Portland for conversion into the **Burnside CEC Hub**.

The Black, Hispanic, Native American and Philippine-American Chambers that together make up the CEC are well-established organizations that have worked in our communities for decades to support entrepreneurship and economic development. They have a proven track record of delivery, enabling businesses from some of our most economically distressed communities to grow and thrive.

Supporting small and micro-businesses has never been more important. Our state is facing economic challenges, and when businesses go under, families have a harder time putting food on the table and making rent. In the end, that puts pressure on public services and costs taxpayers far more than it would to help those businesses stay open.
