Mac Market (Mac Mkt LLC) is asking for your support for our NE Gateway Alpine Ave. Street Improvement Project Phase 2 submission. Mac Market is a historic, restored warehouse in the NE Gateway District that cultivates small business startups and expansions in a community food hall format. It has become an important “third place” for our community and inspires collaboration and innovation that showcases the vibrancy of our regions makers. As hometown developers, we invested in the vision for the NE Gateway District to help revitalize an underutilized urban neighborhood and strongly believe that continuing to improve infrastructure will spur more economic growth, especially in the craftsperson and entrepreneurial space.

This project will construct the second half of Alpine Avenue to incentivize housing and commercial development in the northern end of the NE Gateway District as part of a revitalization effort.
