Dear Committee,

I have been a resident of Hillsboro since 1992, attracted to this community by the balance of rural and suburban land use, and modest size of Hillsboro.

In the last 5-10 years I've seen that balance severely compromised by explosive growth that has negatively impacted the area in loss of farmland and natural landscape. Hillsboro does not need more data centers, and the resulting higher risk to our water shed, more roads, and more traffic. The active growth between Evergreen and Highway 26 is already more than this community wants or needs. I urge you to reject further growth like this and give Hillsboro time to recover the quality of life we came here for. I hope the excessive growth to Hillsboro ceases, and I don't find myself deciding to move away.
