I oppose allowing a third party, private company from entering into contracted agreements to oversee or inspect DEQ requirements for permits. Allowing DEQ to hire private contractors to process pollution permits to increase efficiency is absurd. This is a waste of my tax dollars. The money DEQ would spend on an outside contractor is more than an in-department workforce could do. And, if it is less, then the company contracted to issue permits lack the substantial understanding of the regulations and requirements.
