Chair Bowman and Members of the House Rules Committee,

My name is Georgena Moran, and I serve as Owner of Access for All, LLC (A4A) and Director of Access Recreation (AR). Our company opens recreational opportunities to people with a broad range of abilities, particularly the disability community. A4A works with federal, state and local park and recreation agencies across Oregon and nationwide to offer the public park and trail information that is inclusive, so people can determine for themselves what meets their needs and desired level of adventure. As a person using a mobility device to explore nature and discover new places to recreate, I rely on nonprofit organizations that provide recreational opportunities for people with disabilities. These organizations will be impacted by SB 1517A, and this is why I am writing to you today.

We respectfully **oppose SB 1517A as written**. While we strongly support efforts to improve recreational liability laws in Oregon, the current version of SB 1517 contains ambiguities and exceptions that create uncertainty and represent a step backward in the effort to protect recreation providers and the communities we serve.


Our agency has supported SB 1593 and the protections it provides. We believe the framework reflected in the **-A11 amendments** to SB 1517 achieves those same protections in a clearer and more workable manner, and we support adoption of those amendments.

We also recognize and appreciate the significant work that has gone into seeking compromise on this issue. In that spirit, we agree to supporting the **-A15 amendments**, understanding that while they may not include every preferred protection, they move the policy forward and provide broader applicability of waivers and greater certainty for local parks and recreation providers across Oregon.

We appreciate the Committee's attention to this complex issue and hope that adoption of the compromise amendments will provide clarity and a practical path forward.
