Chair and Members of the House Committee on Rules,

I previously submitted testimony on SB 1516. I am submitting additional testimony to support Rep. Wise's SB 1516-A15 (-15) amendment, which restores a clear, enforceable definition of "end-to-end encryption."

This amendment adds a single sentence that creates an enforcement mechanism by ensuring only the owner of captured license plate data has the capability to decrypt, access, or grant access to the data. That restricts vendor access to sensitive ALPR data, while not restricting lawful law enforcement use.

I oppose SB 1516 as written unless amended to adopt A15 (-15). If the bill cannot be fixed with A15 (-15), I urge you to vote no and revisit the issue next session.
