Measure, Appointment or Topic: SB1516

I oppose SB1516 in its current form. Please amend this bill with a statutory definition of encryption requirements, limit data collection to vehicle data (model/color, license plate, location, and timestamp), and limit use strictly for the purpose of suspected criminal activity.

Oregonians' security and privacy depends upon these restrictions on entities seeking to perform broad surveillance of people's movement and whereabouts. Encryption must also be state-of-the-art and end-to-end to prevent outside parties from gaining access to the data.

Please tighten up this legislation to prohibit use of this technology for general surveillance purpose, as well as prevent interception of its data by hackers.
