These are excellent and vital investments in Oregon's transportation infrastructure as well as the health of our communities people and environment. The more people who walk bike and take transit, the less pressure there is on our system of roads, and the more safe and vital are our communities. In addition, I wish that the proposed changes were more transparently laid out. The bill title or summary do not clearly reflect the bill contents.

In summary, I urge you to oppose these itemized changes:
