I OPPOSE [HB 5204].

*** FEDERAL FUNDS cannot be relied upon. Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) discriminatory per se programs will cut off funds.

Regarding [HB 5204]:

***Eliminate Sections: "203,204,205,206" with extreme prejudice! The aforementioned sections are discriminatory per se and can violate the Fair Housing Act-due to income restrictions and other applied economic barriers.

"...Section 203:.. the Housing and Community Services Department, for single family housing programs, is increased by \$37,771,236, for down payment assistance and development of affordable homes for purchase."

"...Section 204:.. the Housing and Community Services Department, for multifamily rental housing programs, is increased by \$1,900,000, for affordable housing development."

"...Section 205:.. the Housing and Community Services Department, for housing stabilization programs, is increased by \$15,000,000, for energy efficiency projects."

"...Section 206:.. he Housing and Community Services Department, for multifamily rental housing programs, is increased by \$32,585,695, for affordable rental housing development."

***"Affordable Rents and or Housing are a material misrepresentation of fact."

****"Affordable Rents and or Housing are: Government (or Taxpayer) Subsidized

Rental Housing Projects and or Government (or Taxpayer) Subsidized Housing Projects.

"SECTION 402... is increased by \$38,310,820, for nonstate employee compensation changes.

...SECTION 403. ...is increased by \$67,806,701, for nonstate employee compensation changes.

...SECTION 404... is increased by \$36,400,109, for nonstate employee compensation changes.

...SECTION 405... is increased by \$64,152,677, for nonstate employee compensation changes."
